## Table Assignment Student Schedule

**Objective:**


Creating your schedule in an HTML document:

**Storyboard:**

Draw out what your web page will look like, including all correct information.

**Requirements:**

1. The title of your web page should be "Firstname Lastname's Schedule" (Ex. Jane Smith's Schedule)
2. The table should be given a background color, all text (other than where denoted) should be left, and top justified. The width of the table should be set to 75%.
3. The 4 columns should be equal in width.
4. Top row should span the entire table – cell will contain your name, bolded and centered. Give the cell a different background color.
5. Second row; first cell will span 2 columns and should have your home address in the first cell on the left. Second cell on the right will span 2 columns and have a picture of you (taken with digital camera or scanned).
6. The 3rd row will be the header cells; they will give the heading for each column. Give the cells a different background color.
7. The remainder of the cell will have 4 columns, evenly spaced, and will contain your class schedule. Each cell will be left aligned.
