This two-semester course offers students the opportunity to learn and use the HTML programming language, as well as Microsoft Dreamweaver, to make webpages.

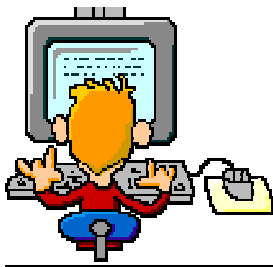

Tutoring Schedule

Grading



Each six weeks average will consist of daily grades and test grades. Tests may include written tests as well as projects. Test grades are entered twice, thus they equal two daily grades. Students will receive a progress report in class 3 weeks into each Six Week grading period so that students and parents will be aware of progress in class. Each semester average will consist of three 6-week grading period averages (80%) plus a comprehensive Final Exam (20%)
